

**RESOLUTION 2017-**

**A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION  
2009-15 WHICH AMENDED RESOLUTION 2005-92  
WHICH ESTABLISHED A POLICY REGARDING  
MEMBERSHIP ON APPOINTED COMMITTEES  
AND BOARDS.**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 2005-92 on May 23, 2005, which established policy regarding citizen membership on committees and boards appointed by the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has found it necessary, based on an Attorney General's Opinion, to rescind Resolution No. 2009-15.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2017 by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Resolution No. 2009-15 shall be rescinded and Resolution No. 2005-92 shall be amended to read as follows:

1. No Any individual citizen may simultaneously serve, as a Board appointee, on more than one ~~committee or~~ board created by the Board of County Commissioners at the same point in time, if the Board's position is an office pursuant to State interpretation.

2. Any appointee now serving simultaneously on more than one ~~committee or~~ board, if the position is an office, shall be asked to choose the committee or board that they desire to remain on, and said choice shall be made within ten (10) days of the effective date of this Resolution. The Board of County Commissioners shall fill any vacancy created.

3.2. This policy shall become effective upon its execution by the Chairman.
