## EVALUATION COMMITTEE MEETING EVALUATE PROPOSALS RECEIVED FOR SOLID WASTE LANDFILLS AND OTHER RELATED FACILITIES BID NO. NC19-001 OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET – CONFERENCE ROOM March 1, 2019 – 10:00 A.M.

A meeting of the Evaluation Committee was held this 1st day of March, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. in the Office of Management and Budget conference room at the James S. Page Governmental Complex, Yulee, Florida to conduct evaluation, score, and rank proposals for the Solid Waste Landfills and Other Related Ancillary Facilities (Bid No. NC19-001), in order to formulate a recommendation to be presented to the Board of County Commissioners. Voting members present were Chris Lacambra, Office of Management and Budget; Becky Diden, Solid Waste; Lynn Diden, Solid Waste; and Robert Companion, Engineering Services. Also present were Grayson Hagins, Contract Manager (non-voting), as facilitator and Heather Nazworth, recording secretary.

Mr. Hagins called the evaluation committee meeting to order at 10:03 a.m. He commented that an Request for Qualification (RFQ) was received from S2L, Inc. Following introductions, Mr. Hagins reminded the committee members that any notes they may have made during the evaluation must be turned over to him at the conclusion of the meeting which will become part of the public record. In addition, if the evaluation committee members have made any notations in any of the proposal books, those would also have to be turned in as well.

Mr. Hagins explained that they would be reviewing each evaluation criteria for the proposer. The evaluation criteria will be on the following eight (8) factors: 1) Compliance with RFQ Instructions [maximum 5 points]; 2) Approach to provide general engineering services [maximum 25 points]; 3) Quality Control [maximum 15 points]; 4) Staff Qualifications and Background [maximum 15 points]; 5) Experience with Similar Projects [maximum 20 points]; 6) Schedule and Availability [maximum 10 points]; 7) References [maximum 5 points]; and 8) Attachments [maximum 5 points]. The total maximum score is 100 points. The evaluation committee members provided reasons for their scores contained in the proposal received. A consensus score was reached for each evaluation criteria item for the firm, based upon discussion of the evaluation committee and the information provided in the proposal received.
