

RESOLUTION NO. 2019- _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING A MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR THE AMELIA CONCOURSE ASSESSMENT AREA ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 2000-37 AND RESOLUTION NO. 2003-141, AND AS FURTHER AMENDED BY RESOLUTION NO. 2006-07 AND RESOLUTION NO. 2009-182; DESCRIBING THE LIEN ASSOCIATED THEREWITH; DIRECTING THAT THE ASSESSMENT ROLL BE CERTIFIED TO THE NASSAU COUNTY TAX COLLECTOR; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida (the “Board”) enacted Ordinance No. 2000-37 (the “Ordinance”) to provide for the creation of Assessment Areas (as described therein) and authorize the imposition of special assessments to fund (1) the construction of Local Improvements to benefit real property located in proposed special assessment areas, and (2) the cost of maintaining such Local Improvements; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Ordinance and Resolution No. 2003-141 adopted by the Board on November 10, 2003, amended and supplemented by Resolution No. 2006-07, and as further amended and supplemented by Resolution No. 2009-182, the Board created and imposed capital and maintenance special assessments within the Amelia Concourse Assessment Area; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Ordinance, the Board is required to adopt an “Annual Assessment Resolution” for each fiscal year to approve the assessment rolls for such fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the 2004 Special Assessment Bond, which is paid with the Capital Assessment proceeds, was satisfied in 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. RECITALS. The above recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Annual Assessment Resolution.

SECTION 2. AUTHORITY. This Annual Assessment Resolution is adopted pursuant to the Ordinance, Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and other applicable provisions of law.

SECTION 3. DEFINITIONS. All capitalized terms used in this Annual Assessment Resolution, not otherwise defined herein, shall have the meanings defined in the Ordinance.

SECTION 4. APPROVAL OF ASSESSMENT ROLL. The maintenance assessment roll on file with the Assessment Coordinator for the Amelia Concourse Assessment Area is hereby approved. Pursuant to Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, the maintenance assessment roll shall be certified to the Nassau County Tax Collector prior to September 15, 2019 and accompanied by a Certificate to Non-Ad Valorem Assessment Roll in substantially the form attached to the Final Assessment Resolution for the Amelia Concourse Assessment Area as Appendix F.

SECTION 5. ASSESSMENT LIENS. Pursuant to the Uniform Assessment Collection Act and the Ordinance, special assessments imposed within the

Amelia Concourse Assessment Area shall constitute a lien against assessed real property equal in rank and dignity with the liens of all state, county, district or municipal taxes and other non-ad valorem assessments. Except as otherwise provided by law, such lien shall be superior in dignity to all other liens, titles and claims, until the ad valorem tax bill for such year is otherwise paid in full pursuant to the Uniform Assessment Collection Act. The lien shall be deemed perfected upon adoption of this Annual Assessment Resolution and shall attach to the real property included on the assessment roll as of January 1, 2019, the lien date for ad valorem taxes.

SECTION 6. CONFLICTS. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any clause, section, other part or application of this Annual Assessment Resolution is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications of this Annual Assessment Resolution.

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SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
