# INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT REGARDING VETERANS' SUICIDE PREVENTION (Northeast Florida Fire Watch Council)

This INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT REGARDING VETERANS' SUICIDE PREVENTION ("Agreement") is made effective as of the <u>14th</u> day of <u>October</u>, 2019 ("Effective Date") by and among BAKER COUNTY, CLAY COUNTY, NASSAU COUNTY, and ST. JOHNS COUNTY, all political subdivisions existing under the laws of the State of Florida, and the CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, a consolidated political subdivision and municipal corporation existing under the laws of the State of Florida (collectively, the "Counties" or individually, "County").

#### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, according to recent reports by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs Suicide Prevention Office, approximately 20 veterans die by suicide each day, which is at least 1.5 times higher than those individuals who have not served in the military; and

WHEREAS, Florida has the third largest veteran population in the nation, only preceded by California and Texas; and

WHEREAS, given the proximity of military installations situated in Northeast Florida, a significant number of veterans reside and seek services in Baker, Clay, Duval, Nassau and St. Johns Counties; and

WHEREAS, the Counties seek to reduce the number of suicides among military veterans living in Northeast Florida by aligning together and using a cooperative, coordinated, and collaborative approach to suicide prevention; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 163.01, *Florida Statutes*, the Counties seek to enter into this Agreement and form a separate multi-jurisdictional governmental entity, made up of representatives from each County and tasked with leading regional efforts in reducing suicide rates among military veterans living in Northeast Florida;

WHEREAS, the governing bodies of each County have reviewed the terms, provisions, and conditions contained herein and determined that entering into this Agreement facilitates the most efficient use of their powers to cooperate, collaborate and coordinate with each other on the basis of mutual advantage regarding the prevention of suicide among military veterans living in Northeast Florida.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants and obligations herein contained and for other good and valuable consideration, the Counties agree and understand as follows:

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# 1. RECITALS.

The recitals above are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

# 2. PARTIES TO THIS AGREEMENT.

Each party to this Agreement is a county or consolidated government existing under the laws of the State of Florida and as such is a general-purpose political subdivision, which has the power to levy taxes and expend funds, as well as general corporate and police powers. These parties are more particularly identified as follows:

Name

Board of County Commissioners Baker County, Florida

Board of County Commissioners Clay County, Florida

City Council, City of Jacksonville Jacksonville (Duval County), Florida

Board of County Commissioners Nassau County, Florida

Board of County Commissioners St. Johns County, Florida

#### 3. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this Agreement is to create a separate multi-jurisdictional governmental entity formed by the Counties pursuant to Section 163.01, *Florida Statutes*, to address veterans' suicide prevention in Northeast Florida and to set forth each County's individual responsibilities related thereto. The Counties believe that combining their efforts to establish a central, single entry point and roadmap for leading regional efforts to reduce suicide rates among military veterans in Northeast Florida is necessary and warranted.

# 4. CREATION OF THE NORTHEAST FLORIDA FIRE WATCH COUNCIL.

a. <u>Fire Watch Council established</u>. In accordance with Section 163.01, *Florida Statutes*, the Counties hereby create a separate multi-jurisdictional governmental entity to be known as the "Northeast Florida Fire Watch Council" (referred to herein as the "Fire Watch Council"). The Fire Watch Council shall serve as a five-county regional public body with the purpose of leading regional efforts in reducing suicide rates among military veterans in Northeast Florida. The Fire Watch Council shall have the powers and duties described in Section 6 below.

- b. <u>Membership</u>; <u>Qualifications</u>. The Fire Watch Council shall be made up of five (5) voting members. Each member shall be appointed by the respective Board of County Commissioners or City Council as follows:
  - (i) one resident of St. Johns County;
  - (ii) one resident of the City of Jacksonville (or Duval County);
  - (iii) one resident of Clay County;
  - (iv) one resident of Baker County; and
  - (v) one resident of Nassau County.

Each member shall be a current or retired member of the United States Armed Services or, alternatively, a person with experience, background and/or a strong interest in military veterans' affairs. Each member shall serve as a representative for the respective County. No commissioner or council member of a County, or other person holding an "office" under Article II, Section 5(a), of the Florida Constitution, may be appointed as a member of the Fire Watch Council.

- c. <u>Member Terms</u>. Fire Watch Council members shall serve for a staggered term of four (4) years or until their successors have been appointed and confirmed. Members shall serve without compensation. The initial term of the St. Johns County, City of Jacksonville, and Clay County members shall be four (4) years, and the initial term of the Baker County and Nassau County members shall be three (3) years. Thereafter, all subsequent member terms shall be four (4) years. Any member appointed for two consecutive full terms shall not be appointed to the next succeeding term.
- d. <u>Officers</u>. The officers of the Fire Watch Council shall include, but not be limited to, a chair and a vice chair. Officers shall be elected by the Fire Watch Council membership for a term of one calendar year. Officers shall hold office until their successors are duly elected. The initial Fire Watch Council chair shall be the member representative for St. Johns County. The chair and the vice chair may serve more than one consecutive term.
- e. Quorum; Organization and proceedings.
  - i. <u>Quorum and voting</u>. Three members shall constitute a quorum of the Fire Watch Council. The Fire Watch Council's decisions and recommendations shall require a concurring vote of a majority of the members voting.
  - ii. <u>Rules of procedure</u>. The Fire Watch Council may establish rules of procedure necessary to govern and conduct its affairs and may adopt bylaws and policies regarding governance and operations; provided, however, such rules, bylaws and policies shall not be inconsistent with applicable state, federal or local laws.
- iii. <u>Meetings</u>. All Fire Watch Council meetings shall be open to the public and comply with Chapter 286, *Florida Statutes* (Florida's Open Meetings Laws), as may be amended. Pursuant to Section 163.01 (18), *Florida Statutes*, the Fire Watch Council may conduct

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public meetings and workshops by means of communications media technology. The notice for any such public meeting or workshop shall state that the meeting or workshop will be conducted through the use of communications media technology; specify how persons interested in attending may do so; and provide a location where communications media technology facilities are available. The participation by a member in a meeting or workshop conducted through communications media technology constitutes that member's presence at such meeting or workshop. As used in this subsection, the term "communications media technology by which all persons attending a public meeting or workshop may audibly communicate. Meetings shall be held at the discretion of the chair, but in no event less than quarterly or 4 (four) times a year.

- iv. <u>Signatory</u>. Unless otherwise provided in the Fire Watch Council's bylaws, the chair shall act as the signatory for the Fire Watch Council and, in the absence of the chair, the vice chair shall act as the signatory.
- County Commission Liaisons; Other liaisons and subject matter experts. Each County v. shall designate one county commissioner or council member of each County to serve as a liaison between the Fire Watch Council and the respective Board of County Commissioners or City Council ("Commissioner-Liaison(s)"). The Fire Watch Council may also assign other liaisons and subject matter experts ("Liaison(s)") to assist the Fire Watch Council with carrying out its purpose and facilitating communications between the Fire Watch Council and various veterans' organizations. Liaisons may include, but shall not be limited to, active or retired military members, social workers, and state and local veteran services providers. The Fire Watch Council shall coordinate with federal, state and private veterans' agencies. Such agencies may include the Florida Department of Veterans' Affairs, the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, mental health providers, and non-profit organizations. Commissioner-Liaisons and other subject matter Liaisons shall not be included in the Fire Watch Council membership for purposes of Chapter 286, Florida Statutes (Florida Open Meetings Laws). Accordingly, Florida Open Meeting Laws shall not apply to communications between Fire Watch Council members and Commission-Liaisons/Liaisons.
- vi. <u>Applicable Laws</u>. The Fire Watch Council is a governmental entity and public agency pursuant to Section 163.01(3)(b), *Florida Statutes*, and is subject to all applicable state laws governing governmental entities including, but not limited to, Chapter 112, Part III (Code of Ethics for Public Officers and Employees), Chapter 119 (Public Records), and Chapter 286 (Florida Open Meetings Laws).

# 5. GEOGRAPHICAL AREA SERVED BY THE FIRE WATCH COUNCIL.

The geographical area served by the Fire Watch Council under this Agreement shall be the combined geographical areas of each of the Counties, whose geographical areas are contained in the legal description found in Chapter 7, *Florida Statutes*. The City of Jacksonville is exercising its county powers in the approval of this Agreement as it relates to Duval County, Florida,

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pursuant to the authority contained in Section 3.01 of the City of Jacksonville Charter. The term "City of Jacksonville" for purposes of this Agreement shall mean Duval County, Florida.

# 6. POWERS AND DUTIES; ANNUAL REPORT; NO DEBT OBLIGATIONS.

a. <u>Powers and duties</u>. In carrying out the purposes set forth in this Agreement, the Fire Watch Council shall have the following powers and duties to:

- i. Make and enter contracts in its own name, including but not limited to, contracts and Memorandum of Understandings (MOUs) between the Fire Watch Council and public and private partners in the development of programs, activities and resources for veterans' suicide prevention;
- ii. Coordinate veterans' suicide prevention efforts, prioritizing research activities and funding, and strengthening collaboration across public and private sectors;
- iii. Provide an aspirational, innovative, all-hands-on-deck approach to reducing veterans' suicide;
- iv. Work side-by-side with partners from federal, state, and local governments as well as private and non-profit entities to provide veterans with services they need to prevent suicide;
- v. Work together with non-profit organizations, faith-based and other community-based groups, first responders, stake holders and the veterans community at large to foster cultures of care for veterans' mental health and physical health in an effort to prevent suicide;
- vi. Create a roadmap for local and regional efforts to prevent suicide among veterans with community integration that brings together veteran organizations with local governments for streamlined access to services and support including employment, health, housing, benefits, recreation, education and social connection;
- vii. Harmonize efforts with federal, state and local governments and nongovernmental entities to prevent veterans' suicide;
- viii. Create an implementation strategy for resources that may be required and potential policy changes directed at achieving the goal of veterans' suicide prevention;
- ix. Increase veterans' access to suicide prevention programs, activities and mental health facilities through programs and planning strategies implemented under this Agreement;

- x. Research grant opportunities for funding of veterans' suicide prevention programs and activities;
- xi. File applications for federal, state and privately funded grants in order to obtain funding for veterans' suicide prevention programs and activities consistent with this Agreement and subject to applicable laws and appropriation of funds;
- xii. Make and enter into agreements with each County regarding veterans' suicide prevention, including the selection of one of the Counties to assist with administering this Agreement;
- xiii. Approve the manner in which funds will be disbursed among the Counties pursuant to this Agreement;
- xiv. Develop and approve the Fire Watch Council's annual budget for carrying out the purposes described herein;
- xv. Provide oversight and guidance in conjunction with the veterans' prevention programs and activities implemented pursuant to this Agreement;
- xvi. Accept grants, gifts or other types of monetary assistance, except for loans, as allowed by law and consistent with the purposes of this Agreement;
- xvii. Preserve, register and protect its intellectual property rights in any logos, trademarks, copyrights and other intellectual property rights;
- xviii. Perform any other appropriate duties necessary and consistent with the purposes of this Agreement; and
  - xix. Make requests to the Counties for financial support to assist with exercising the powers and duties herein provided that any such request shall be subject to the approval of the Counties.

b. <u>Report</u>. The Fire Watch Council shall provide the Counties with a written report no less than annually regarding its findings, strategies, programs and progress made towards veterans' suicide prevention in Northeast Florida.

c. <u>No Debt Obligations</u>. The Fire Watch Council shall not incur any debt or financial obligations in the exercise of its powers and duties granted herein. Additionally, the Fire Watch Council shall not have any authority to obligate the Counties, financially or otherwise, in any manner.

# 7. ADMINISTRATIVE AND STAFF SUPPORT; FINANCIAL SUPPORT.

a. <u>Administrative and staff support</u>.

. .......

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The City of Jacksonville shall provide administrative and staff support and assistance from the City of Jacksonville's Office of Grants and Contract Compliance (the "Administrator"), on an in-kind or cost reimbursement basis as agreed upon between the Fire Watch Council and the City of Jacksonville pursuant to a memorandum of understanding. The Administrator shall:

- i. Serve as the fiscal agent;
- ii. Provide administrative support, if needed, for Fire Watch Council meetings;
- iii. Assist with filing grant applications on behalf of the Fire Watch Council;
- iv. Assist the Fire Watch Council with preparing and submitting disbursement requests in accordance with the Trust Fund (defined below) requirements;
- v. Review contracts and programs for compliance with the contract and program terms; and
- vi. Assist with procuring any services, subject to applicable federal, state or local laws.

#### b. Financial Support; Trust Fund.

(i) <u>Financial Support</u>. Subject to lawful appropriation, Baker County, Clay County, Nassau County, St. Johns County and Duval County may each provide an initial financial contribution (the "Initial County Contributions") to the Fire Watch Council within (30) days of the effective date of this Agreement. The Fire Watch Council shall use the Initial County Contributions consistent with the powers, duties, and purposes set forth herein. The Initial County Contributions shall be deposited into the Trust Fund (defined below). No County will be obligated to provide any financial support under this Agreement or to the Fire Watch Council unless expressly agreed to by such County. Any cost-sharing formula regarding the Counties' financial support under this Agreement shall be mutually agreed upon by the Counties.

(ii) <u>Trust Fund</u>. The Administrator shall establish a trust fund account called The Fire Watch - Northeast Florida Veterans' Suicide Prevention Trust Fund (the "Trust Fund") within the City of Jacksonville's Accounting Division to receive and deposit contributions, grant funds and other monetary donations made to the Fire Watch Council. Funds from the Trust Fund shall only be disbursed by the City's Chief Financial Officer at the written request and approval of the Fire Watch Council.

#### 8. STATE REQUIREMENTS.

Unless otherwise provided herein, the Counties intend to incorporate into this Agreement the duties and obligations governing interlocal agreements under Chapter 163, *Florida Statutes*, as well as any other applicable federal, state and local rules and regulations.

#### 9. JOINT UNDERSTANDING.

The terms and conditions in this Agreement reflect the joint understanding between the parties.

### 10. PRIOR AGREEMENTS.

It is understood and agreed that this document incorporates and includes all prior negotiations, correspondence, conversations, agreements, or understandings applicable to the matters contained herein and the parties agree that there are no commitments, agreements, or understandings concerning the subject matter of this Agreement that are not contained in this document. Accordingly, it is agreed that no deviation from the terms hereof shall be predicated upon any prior representation or agreements whether oral or written.

#### 11. AMENDMENT

It is agreed that no modification, amendment, or alteration of the terms or conditions contained in this Agreement shall be effective unless contained in a written document executed with the same formality and of equal dignity herewith executed by each participating County.

# **12.** NOTICE

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the remainder of this Agreement shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.

#### **15. WAIVER OF RIGHTS.**

Any waiver at any time by any party hereto of its rights with respect to any matter arising in connection with this Agreement shall not be considered a waiver with respect to any subsequent default or matter.

#### 16. COUNTERPARTS.

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, and each counterpart, when executed, shall have the efficacy of a signed original. True and correct copies of such signed counterparts may be used in lieu of the originals for any purpose.

#### **17.** AGREEMENT TERM.

The term of this Agreement shall commence on the date that the last party executes this Agreement and end eight (8) years thereafter, unless sooner terminated by the parties. This Agreement may be renewed for successive eight (8) year periods upon a majority vote of each participating County.

#### **18. TERMINATION.**

This interlocal agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 2019, by and between Nassau County, Florida (the "County") and the Florida Governmental Utility Authority (the "FGUA" or "Authority"), a legal entity and public body created by interlocal agreement pursuant to Section 163.01(7) Florida Statutes.

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County and the Jacksonville Electric Authority ("JEA") entered into that certain Nassau County/JEA Water and Wastewater Interlocal Agreement, dated as of December 17, 2001, concerning the provision of water and wastewater utility services by JEA within the County; and

WHEREAS, that interlocal agreement contains a right of first refusal for the County to acquire the JEA water and wastewater utility facilities within the County (the "JEA Facilities") in the event JEA intends to sell those facilities; and

WHEREAS, on September 27, 2019, the County was provided notice by JEA of its intent to sell the JEA Facilities within the County; and

WHEREAS, the County has a ninety (90) day period within which it must notify JEA of the County's intention with regard to exercising its right to acquire the JEA Facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the County desires to obtain professional management and financial analysis services to evaluate the feasibility and implications of acquiring the JEA Facilities; and

WHEREAS, the County and the FGUA previously entered into that certain Interlocal Agreement Relating to the Provision of Utility Services to the Nassau County Amelia Utility (NAU) Water and Wastewater Utility System pursuant to which the FGUA provides utility services to the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the FGUA possesses the unique experience and expertise to provide the County with water and wastewater utility acquisition feasibility analysis, ownership and operations services.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the parties hereto agree as follows:

**SECTION 1. Incorporation.** The above recitals are true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

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# SECTION 2. Scope of Services.

#### A. Summary of Services to be Rendered

The FGUA will perform the "Scope of Services" set forth in Attachment A, which is incorporated herein by reference, to the County to assist the County in evaluating its purchase option for the JEA Facilities. The FGUA will utilize the services of various contractors under contract with the FGUA who possess the necessary skills and expertise to provide relevant portions of the Scope of Services in a professional and workmanlike manner. These contractors include, but are not limited to, Raftelis Financial Consultants, Inc. ("Raftelis", and formerly known as Public Resources Management Group, Inc.), Government Services Group, Inc. ("GSG"), and U.S. Water Services Corporation ("USWSC"). The FGUA and its contractors will exercise the same degree of care, skill, and diligence in the performance of the Scope of Services as is provided by a professional of like experience, knowledge and resources, under similar circumstances.

# **B.** County Responsibilities

For the FGUA to complete the Scope of Services, the County agrees to assist the FGUA in securing from the JEA all data, plans and related information concerning the JEA Facilities (the JEA Data") reasonably required by the FGUA. The County shall also provide to the FGUA all available estimated customer growth projections consistent with its community plans and financial information which may assist the analysis.

#### **SECTION 3.** Compensation.

#### A. Fees

The County shall pay the FGUA for services rendered based upon hours expended at the rates set forth in Attachment B, which is incorporated herein by reference. The total compensation, including fees and costs (specified in B. below) is reasonably not expected to exceed \$55,600.

#### B. Costs

In addition to fees specified above, expenses incurred in the provision of the Scope of Services will be reimbursed by the County to the FGUA, including, but not limited to copy costs, long distance telephone costs, and express mail costs. Travel expenses, to the extent required, will be reimbursed in accordance with the provisions governing the travel of public officers and employees contained in Section 112.061, Florida Statutes.

# C. Payment

The FGUA will provide an itemized statement outlining the services rendered and costs incurred to the County on a monthly basis for fees and costs incurred the previous month. All invoices shall be paid in accordance with the Florida Prompt Payment Act.

#### SECTION 4. Schedule.

#### A. Timing.

The Scope of Services will be substantially completed within sixty (60) days of the receipt by the FGUA of the JEA Data.

#### **B.** Uncontrollable Forces

The FGUA shall not be considered to be in default of this agreement if delays in or failure of performance shall be due to Uncontrollable Forces, the effect of which, by the exercise of reasonable diligence, the non-performing party could not avoid. The term "Uncontrollable Forces" shall mean any event which results in the prevention or delay of performance by a party of its obligations under this Agreement and which is beyond the reasonable control of the nonperforming party. It includes, but is not limited to fire, flood, earthquakes, storms, lightning, epidemic, war, riot, civil disturbance, sabotage, and governmental actions.

# **SECTION 5. Records.**

#### A. Public Records

The FGUA and the County shall comply with public records laws embodied in Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, and specifically shall:

1. Keep and maintain public records required by the County or the FGUA in order to perform the Scope of Services described herein.

2. Upon request from the other party provide any requested public records or allow the requested records to be inspected or copied within a reasonable time by the other party.

3. Ensure that public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements are not disclosed except as authorized by law for the duration of the Agreement term, and thereafter.

4. Transfer, at no cost, all public records in possession of the other party upon termination of this Agreement and destroy any duplicate public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements. All records stored electronically must be provided upon request from the other party, in a format that is compatible with the information technology systems of that party. If the FGUA keeps and maintains public records upon the conclusion of this Agreement, the FGUA shall meet all applicable requirements for retaining public records that would apply to the County.

5. If either party does not comply with a public record request related to the Scope of Services, that failure shall be treated as breach of this Agreement and the contract provisions shall be enforced accordingly. Additionally, if either party fails to provide records when requested, they may be subject to penalties under Section 119.10, Florida Statutes and reasonable costs of enforcement, including attorney fees.

# IF EITHER PARTY HAS QUESTIONS REGARDING THE APPLICATION OF CHAPTER 119, FLORIDA STATUTES, AS TO ITS DUTY TO PROVIDE PUBLIC RECORDS RELATING TO THIS AGREEMENT, CONTACT THE

#### SECTION 6. Miscellaneous Provisions.

#### A. Notice/Project Manager

The project manager for the FGUA will be Stephen M. Spratt, System Manager. The project manager for the County shall be Michael Mullin. All notices and correspondence shall be addressed as follows:

#### B. Severability

The invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability of any provision of this Agreement, or the occurrence of any event rendering any portion or provision of this Agreement void, shall in no way affect the validity or enforceability of any other portion or provision of the Agreement. Any void provision shall be deemed severed from the Agreement and the balance of the Agreement shall be construed and enforced as if the Agreement did not contain the particular portion or provision held to be void.

#### C. Termination

This Agreement may be terminated by either party for convenience upon thirty (30) days' prior written notice to the other party. This Agreement may be terminated by either party immediately upon written notice to the other party in the event of the substantial failure of that party to perform in accordance with the terms of this Agreement. Unless the FGUA is in breach of this Agreement, the FGUA shall be paid for services rendered through the date of termination.

#### **D.** Entirety of Agreement

The County and the FGUA agree that this Agreement sets forth the entire Agreement between the parties related to the matters contained with the Scope of Services, and that there are no promises or understandings other than those stated herein. This Agreement supersedes all prior agreements, contracts, proposals, representations, negotiations, letters or other communications between the County and FGUA pertaining to the Scope of Services, whether written or oral. None of the provisions, terms and conditions contained in this Agreement may be added to, modified, superseded or otherwise altered except by written instrument executed by the parties hereto.

#### E. Filing

This Interlocal Agreement shall be filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Nassau County and with the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Leon County.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF,** the County and the FGUA have caused this Interlocal Agreement to be duly executed and entered into on the date first above written.

# FLORIDA GOVERNMENTAL UTILITY AUTHORITY

# CONSULTING SERVICES FOR ASSISTING NASSAU COUNTY IN THE EVALUATION OF THE POTENTIAL PURCHASE OF THE JEA UTILITY SYSTEM (NASSAU COUNTY)

#### **SCOPE OF SERVICES**

The services to be performed by FGUA as presented below are related to providing assistance to Nassau County (the "County") to provide acquisition consulting services, including to determine a "Purchase Price," pursuant to the provisions delineated in the Nassau County/JEA Water and Wastewater Interlocal Agreement as amended (the "Agreement"), for water, wastewater and reclaimed water facilities currently owned by JEA that exist within the boundaries of Nassau County (the "JEA Assets") and to assist the County and the FGUA and its advisors with its evaluation and any other transition services as may be requested (the "Project"). The Agreement makes reference to a "Purchase Price" as stated in Section 5.5 of the Agreement which will be a primary focus for the FGUA as it assists the County with its evaluations and strategic planning activities. With respect to the performance of the Project, FGUA will rely upon, to the extent available and considered reliable, information and financial analyses provided by JEA or as may have been recently developed or prepared by other consultants of the FGUA, including the System Manager, with respect to the management of the existing County utility systems and the potential acquisition of the JEA Nassau System.

The scope of services does not include any utility acquisition services assuming an affirmative decision to purchase the JEA Assets, including but not limited to, the following:

- Assisting in utility acquisition negotiations with JEA;
- Preparation of Acquisition documents such as a purchase and sales agreement or FGUA transition agreements;
- Preparation of a bond feasibility report and other supporting documents necessary to finance the acquisition of the JEA Assets;
- Development of utility rate and service ordinances, policies, or procedures and contract service agreements that may be necessary for utility operation;
- Preparation for and attendance of any public hearings as required by Florida Statutes associated with the purchase of a utility system;
- Providing transition services that may be necessary to transfer ownership of the JEA Assets to the County; and
- Other related acquisition services.

The scope of services to be performed by FGUA with respect to this engagement will include the following tasks:

# Task 1. Accumulation of Required Data.

Provisions in the Agreement will be reviewed to identify the data required to comply with the determining of "Purchase Price," including but not limited to: financial statements, fixed asset accounting and other financial data, income and property and cash contribution statements, loan/debt documents, original acquisition agreements and documents, regulatory filings, developer agreements, customer and sales statistics, utility maps and GIS records, water and wastewater treatment plant operating permits, consumptive use permits, and other regulatory permits, and other data relevant to the task. This task involves:

- a) Review and analysis of existing data provided to the County by JEA for sufficiency and accuracy.
- b) Searches and discussions to determine the existence of data sources other than JEA.
- c) Discussions with County legal counsel and the FGUA to assist with understanding Agreement provisions.
- d) Discussions with FGUA System Management, USWSC and engineering staff regarding confirmation of data and locations.
- e) As required prepare request for additional information and clarification of data that may be considered to be deficient/incomplete and/or clarification of data.
- f) Development of a computer model for retention, development and calculation of data.

# Task 2. Data Analysis.

Based on the information provided by JEA and others, FGUA will evaluate and analyze the data to validate the net plant investment located within the County boundaries in support of the determination of a preliminary "Purchase Price" calculation in accordance with the Agreement and other evaluation methods; and identify any issues or concerns relative to terms of the existing Agreement. This task involves:

- a) Accumulation of asset/facility, contracts, agreements and other data by service area location with the objective to identify:
  - i. Function of service or asset facility categories;
  - Gross and net plant in service expressed on an original cost basis by individual fixed asset record included in the fixed asset register for the JEA utility system assets for the most recently completed Fiscal Year ended September 30, 2018 (the "Fiscal Year") with emphasis for assets located within the County (the "JEA Assets");
  - iii. Depreciable service life for each individual fixed asset record included in the fixed asset register for the JEA Assets for the Fiscal Year;
  - iv. The estimated cost of disposition and salvage value, if any, for each individual asset included as a JEA Asset, if known;
  - v. If not included in the fixed asset register for the JEA Assets, to identify the amount of construction-work-in-progress (CWIP) for each specific asset included in the CWIP for the Fiscal Year, regarding the CWIP information request above, to recognize the estimated cost to complete each project and the amount of funds appropriated for and encumbered to the project in support of project completion;
  - vi. JEA fixed asset capitalization policies and procedures,

- vii. Semi-annual debt service payments for each senior and subordinate lien debt that is associated with the financing of any JEA Assets and the allocation percentage of such debt, with corresponding work papers and analyses, to the County;
- viii. JEA cash balances by fund with emphasis on capital-related funds allocable to or funding the JEA Assets;
- ix. The detailed customer statistics and billed water sales and wastewater flow information by service area for each fiscal year since the execution of the Agreement;
- x. To determine the Finished Water Produced (annual flow and coincident maximum day demand when aggregating all plants) for each fiscal year since the execution of the Agreement and the total Wastewater Treated (annual flow and coincident maximum month demand when aggregating all plants);
- xi. How JEA rates and impact fees were developed based on Rate Study and Impact Fee study reports, including the amount of the impact fee that is attributable to the water supply and treatment, wastewater treatment and disposal, and the water and wastewater primary conveyance functions; and
- xii. other information as may be necessary.
- b) Evaluate the compiled data as provided by JEA for consistency among documents and reports and information provided to the County by JEA and identify data "gaps" and issues in such data. To the extent it is determined that the data to be relied upon is considered as being incomplete, inaccurate, missing or contains other non-conforming attributes for use in calculating "Purchase Price," develop assumptions and analyses in order to provide the necessary basis in support of the calculation of the "Purchase Price".
- c) Meet with County staff, FGUA team members and other County consultants and advisors to review findings.

#### Task 3. Calculate Preliminary "Purchase Price."

Pursuant to Section 5.5 of the Agreement and in accordance with accounting and valuation principles, accumulate the analyzed facility, real estate and other utility asset values by functional component which would include: i) capital amount paid to purchase or improve or expand the JEA Assets; ii) contributions made by developers; and iii) depreciation on non-contributed and contributed assets all as delineated in the Agreement. Based on the information provided, FGUA will determine or calculate the estimated functional components of the purchase price and will document data sources, calculations, assumptions, and highlight issues relative to such calculations. It may be required that this process initially utilize certain assumptions, data, amounts and conditions that have not been fully resolved and therefore are provided to reflect the magnitude and direction of the "Purchase Price" for informational purposes. The analysis will include up to three (3) sensitivity evaluations to assist in the preparation of a potential range in values if data gaps and assumptions are required in the development of the preliminary "Purchase Price".

#### Task 4. Preliminary System and Customer Rate Impact Analysis.

Based on the evaluations and analyses conduced in the previous tasks, FGUA will prepare a preliminary system impact evaluation associated with the transition of the JEA Assets and

customers served (based on a financial evaluation only, no consideration of asset condition will be assumed since it beyond the scope of this work authorization); the analysis will not be a detailed cost of service evaluation but a desktop evaluation of the possible financial impact to the County customer rates based on the current JEA cost of operations and capital for the County and FGUA cost (a one-year evaluation - the analysis will consider the JEA assets as a standalone utility and consolidated with the Nassau Amelia Utility). The analysis will assume that water and wastewater capacity will be provided by JEA on a wholesale basis with no payment of impact fees to secure such capacity.

# Task 5. Meetings.

During the preparation of the analyses as documented in this scope of services, FGUA will need to attend several meetings and conference calls with the County and other advisors for the County. The scope of services includes the attendance of two (2) on-site working group meetings to obtain information necessary for obtaining information (may include meeting with JEA representatives) conducting the analysis, review cf findings and any related documents, and discuss any issues that may be identified during the course of the evaluation. The attendance of any additional meetings will be considered as an additional service to this scope of services.

# Task 6. Preparation of Technical Memorandum.

As required, the FGUA team will prepare a technical memorandum which would present the analyses, assumptions and results of the work for consideration by the County.

# ADDITIONAL SERVICES

During the study, the County may request additional services to be performed by FGUA. Such services will not be conducted until authorized by the County and the FGUA as mutually agreed between all the parties. The FGUA will be billed for such additional services being rendered to the County based on the direct labor (billing) and other direct standard cost rates as set forth in this agreement. Examples of such additional services include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Attendance at any additional meetings in addition to what is anticipated in this scope of 1. services:
- Requests for updated analyses and/or additional financial scenarios after substantial 2. completion of the initial work;
- Performance of a part or all of the additional follow up pre-acquisition and acquisition 3. services;
- Costs incurred due to delays in the duration of the project by the County, the FGUA or 4. major changes in policy as directed by the County to the FGUA that is different from what is implied in the scope of services (which would include changes in scope due to the lack of requested data);
- Review and design of monthly water and wastewater service charges or fees for the 5. existing County or the potentially acquired system served by the JEA Assets or the consolidation of rates into a uniform rate structure;

- 6. Review and design of water and wastewater impact fees, miscellaneous services charges or similar cost recovery fees for the existing County or the potentially acquired system served by the JEA Assets; and
- 7. Delays in the Project schedule which are not the fault of FGUA, which may have impacts on analyses performed, and which would affect the budget for the scope of services reflected herein.

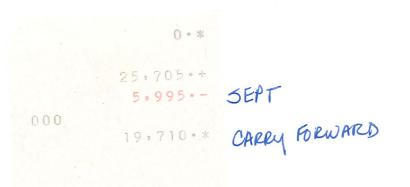
