<u>SS191021 - 3:33:00(Tab A)</u> Discussion regarding due diligence and consider authorizing the Chairman to sign an Interlocal Agreement with Florida Governmental Utility Authority, Contract No. CM2760, for evaluation of feasibility and implications related to acquiring JEA facilities in Nassau County.

Discussion: Mr. Mullin reviewed the JEA Due Diligence Agreement with Florida Governmental Utility Authority (FGUA).
