Air Conditioning FY 19/20 Replacement Program - Other County Facilities/Parks:

- o James S. Page Gov. Bldg- Chambers: HVAC Replacement On Scheduled 7/29-7/31
- o Historic Courthouse: Replace 2 HVAC Units Scheduling after hours. After Aug 1st

Generator Installation:

- Multi-Use Facilities 30 % Completed. No change.
- o Public Service Generator 15% Prep work in progress, Equipment lead time 15 Weeks.
- O Detention Center- Generator <u>Upgrade previous list of equipment and reviewing</u> generator specs. Project is moving in a different direction to obtain the Generator for this location.

Animal Control:

- o Cattery Expansion-HVAC System-60% Project is in process.
- o K-9 Play Yard: Site planning for K9- walk & play yard. Still Pending.
 - O Staked out area, to be cleared, Solid Waste will schedule.

Burney Park Walkover:

 - o 3rd Phase ADA Handrails Materials on Order, project at 30%. Project underway.

Callahan Ball Park:

Detention Center:

- Outside Security Upgrades Tony is working on the purchasing for the Security Projects

 - HVAC Installation <u>Equipment on order, expected to ship 7/27, electric work</u> to start in the next 2 weeks.
 - Insulation of the Attic Awarded bid, pending Insurance Documents.
 - Walls to be constructed- In process.

Sheriff's Office Admin Buildings:

Yulee Road Dept:
