PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR NASSAU COUNTY

entered into this THIS AMENDMENT day of ___, 2020 by and between the BOARD OF COUNTY COUNTY, FLORIDA, COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU a political subdivision of the State of Florida, (hereinafter referred to as "County") and Government Services Group, Inc. (GSG) located at 1500 Mahan Drive, Suite 250, Tallahassee, Florida, 32308 (hereinafter referred to as "Consultant").

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement dated June 24, 2020, for professional services for the development of the County's CARES Act Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provided for an initial term of one (1) month beginning June 24, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on July 6, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners directed staff to negotiate a contract with GSG for professional services in relation to implementing the CARES Act Expenditure Plan; and

WHEREAS, on July 29, 2020, the parties amended and extended the Agreement for an additional two (2) weeks beginning August 1, 2020, and ending August 15, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on August 12, 2020 the parties amended and extended the Agreement for an additional two (2) weeks beginning August 16, 2020, and ending August 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on August 18, 2020, as directed by the Board of County Commissioners, a negotiation session was held between County Staff and GSG regarding an amendment to the existing Agreement to extend the term of the Agreement and scope of services to be provided; and

WHEREAS, the negotiation session of August 18, 2020 resulted in a revised scope of services and fee schedule,

attached to this Agreement as Attachment "A", providing additional clarity as to hours and expense categorized by funded Nassau CARES Expenditure Plan "Tiers"; and

WHEREAS, provisions in the CARES Act provide for the potential of a "callback" of CARES Act funds from the County by the US Treasury and/or State of Florida. As such, and in addition to protecting the health, safety and general welfare of the public, the County finds it is in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County to amend and extend this Agreement for an additional four (4) months beginning August 31, 2020, and ending December 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the parties agree to increase the total Agreement in the amount not to exceed \$850,500. Phase 1 \$112,500 and Phase 2 \$738,000 based on the receipt of the full allocation of \$15,464,380 as approved by the Florida Legislature, and all four "Tiers" of the Nassau CARES Expenditure Plan being funded by the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the parties agree, as defined in the scope of services attached to this Agreement as Attachment "A", that the total not to exceed amount of the Agreement will vary dependent upon the Board of County Commissioners funding of each Tier of the Nassau CARES Expenditure Plan and the amount of actual CARES Act funds received by the County from the State of Florida;

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. This Agreement is hereby amended to extend the term four (4) months beginning August 31, 2020, and ending December 30, 2020.

- This Agreement is hereby amended to increase the 2. compensation of the Agreement with a total sum not to exceed \$850,500 for services provided under the County's CARES Act (Nassau CARES) funded through the Florida Division of Emergency Management. Notwithstanding the above, the not to exceed amount of this Agreement will vary based on the Board of County Commissioners funding of each "Tier" of the Nassau CARES Expenditure Plan and the actual amount of CARES Act funding received by the County from the State of Florida. Attachment "A" of this Agreement defines the fee amount and hours associated with each Tier of the Nassau CARES Expenditure Plan broken into three scenerios.
- This Agreement is hereby amended to include Phase 2 3. which includes program review, program management, and program closeout/wrap up and monitoring services for the Nassau CARES Expenditure Plan based upon the funding of each "Tier" of the plan by the Board of County Commissioners as defined in Attachment "A" of this Agreement. Based on CARES Act guidelines as of the date of this addendum, Phase 2 services that extend beyond December 30, 2020, are not eligible for reimbursement under the CARES Act. No work shall be commenced by GSG after the date of December 30, 2020 without from the Board of approval County Commissioners. Notwithstanding the above, event the regulatory controls associated with CARES Act funds are amended by the State and/or Federal government allowing CARES Act funds to be expended after December 30, 2020, this agreement may be extended by mutual agreement, in writing, between the

two parties and work by GSG executing the scope of services in Attachment "A" may continue without additional approval by the Board of County Commissioners. However, in no case shall the scope of services or associated fee exceed the defined not to exceed amount for each "Tier" of the Nassau CARES Expenditure Plan as defined in Attachment "A". Consultant shall provide professional services in accordance with the Scope of Services set forth in Attachment "A" for Phase 2, hereto and incorporated by reference.

4. All other provisions of said Agreement not in conflict with this Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.

FEES AND EXPENSES

The prior Agreement dated June 24, 2020, is amended to increase the compensation of the original Agreement with a total sum not to exceed \$850,500 (Phase One - \$112,500 and Phase Two - \$738,000) for services provided under the County's CARES Act (Nassau CARES) funded through the Florida Division of Emergency Management.

For the professional services and specialized assistance provided by the Project Team, proposes a time and expense arrangement for professional fees and out of pocket expenses. All expenses related to these requested services will be billed in accordance with section 112.061, Florida Statutes. Given the condensed timeframe and complex nature of the objectives, we are proposing to use a higher than normal level of experienced and senior level staff to complete the project.

GSG's proposed budget for Phase Two provides several scenarios for the County and considers the Proposed Funding Tiers in the *Nassau CARES* Plan. As such, GSG's proposed project approach provides different scenarios for funding such as:
