### Paved Road Overlay Program (Level & Overlay):

- o Shoulder Prep Road Department Staff Completed
- Overlays Hubbard Construction All roads have been completed; CEI form reviewing quantities and submittals for project invoicing and closeout
- o Temporary Striping Road Department Staff Completed
- Permanent Striping Roadside Specialties Striping has begun; completion early October
- Shoulder Finish Work Road Department Staff Completed by late October

# <u>Double Chip Seal Program:</u> \* Project recently combined Phases 2 & 3 to be completed at same time Phase 1 Roads (Pine Drive, Palm Drive, Donnie Lane, Chem Cell Road, Gregg Street, Crews Creek Avenue & Lang Road)

- o Phase 1 Road Prep (drainage & road base) Road Department Staff 100% Completed
- o Phase 1 Chip Seal Application- Asphalt Paving Systems- 100% Completed

**Phase 2 Roads** (Mobley Heights Road, Merlin Road, Live Oak Drive, Palm Circle, Mill Creek Road, Maria Avenue & Shirley Avenue)

- Phase 2 Road Prep (drainage & road base) Road Department Staff 25% Completed
- O Phase 2 Chip Seal Application Asphalt Paving Systems Scheduled for week of November 16<sup>th</sup>

# Citrona Drive Storm Drain Replacement Project:

Project began August 5<sup>th</sup> – DB Civil Construction – 100% Complete; Invoice submitted,
 and processed

### **Eastwood Drive Outfall Ditch Project:**

Project began July 27<sup>th</sup> - Pars Construction Services LLC - 40% Complete; Additional work added to increase the height of the retaining wall. Anticipated Completion late October 2020.

## Owens Farm Road Cross Drain Replacement Project:

Project scheduled to begin in September 2020 – Jax Utilities Management – Construction is 100% Complete, once grass is established per Nassau County Standards the project may be closed out.

# Sidewalk Repairs Project:

- o Grinding "Uneven" Sidewalk Sections Road Department Staff 98% Completed
  - o Performing this work vs contracting out replacements saved an estimated \$50k
- o Replacing Broken Sidewalk Sections (17,000 SF)- Jax Utilities Management -
  - <u>5% Complete</u> Project started August 24, 2020 on east side of County District 1; project awarded at July 27<sup>th</sup> BOCC meeting
- Replacing Damaged or Missing ADA Mats (195) *Jax Utilities Management*—
   50% Complete Project started August 24, 2020 on east side of County District 1; project awarded at July 27<sup>th</sup> BOCC meeting

#### **Road Department Administration:**

- Maintenance Helper Positions (8). On Hold until COVID-19 restrictions are lifted and consideration is made regarding the possibility of contracting mowing services out.
