CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

WHEREAS, the City of Fernandina Beach, Florida provides quality Emergency Medical Services to the citizens of Nassau County and;

WHEREAS, there has been demonstrated that there is a need for the City of Fernandina Beach to operate in this County to provide services to the citizens of this County and;

WHEREAS, the City of Fernandina Beach has indicated that it will comply with all the requirements of the Emergency Medical Services Act of 1973, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County hereby issues a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to the City of Fernandina Beach.

In issuing this certificate it is understood that the above-named ambulance service will meet the requirements of State legislation and provide emergency services on a twenty-four hour basis for the following area(s) as limited below:

1. Emergency and non-emergency BLS.
2. Emergency and non-emergency ALS.
3. Limited to the geographical boundaries of the City of Fernandina Beach unless requested by Nassau County Fire Rescue.
