<u>ss200902 - 9:01:53</u> Dr. Eugenia Ngo-Seidel, Nassau County Health Department, came forward to provide a public health update related to Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). As of September 1, 2020, the County has a total of 1,728 cases positive cases of which 1,619 were residents and 109 non-residents. She indicated that the positivity rate is 8.2 percent. There are currently twenty-five hospital cases and six additional deaths since last week. Dr. Seidel advised that the key messaging this week is to practice safety mitigation during the Labor Day Holiday; and, keeping workplaces safe and reducing job exposures. She

commended parents on being proactive by keeping children home from school when sick.

<u>SS200902</u> - 9:05:27 Greg Foster, Emergency Management Director, came forward to advise that Emergency Management continues to support the Florida Department of Health's mission. He advised that the key messaging is mirroring the Department of Health on being safe and keeping children home from school if showing any signs of illness. Director Foster informed the Board that there is a greater demand on the reserves for Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) and he is anticipating making additional purchases to supply those demands. There are currently no tropical storm threats to the east coast.

<u>SS200902 - 9:07:57 (Tab C)</u> Taco Pope to provide an update on the Nassau County Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act.

Discussion: Mr. Pope advised that the first application period for the Small Business Assistance Program closed with 62 approved grants. The applicants have been notified and checks will be sent through the mail by the beginning of next week. He reported that the approval rate was over 85 percent with only nine applications that were deemed ineligible and two that are pending legal review. Mr. Pope advised that the second application period for the Small Assistance Program received total 118 Business а applications. These applications are in the review process with the hope that the approval rate would be similar to the first application period and checks would be mailed in the next coming weeks.
