Generator Installation:

- o Multi-Use Facilities: Generator: 30% Completed. No change.

 - Equipment has been purchased; installation Contractor is on site.

Animal Control:

- o Cattery Expansion-HVAC System- 98%
 - Contractor is complete. Final bill is with ASA Gillette. Sink is ordered and will be installed in house.
- o K-9 Play Yard: Site planning for K9- walk & play yard. Still Pending.
 - Staked out area, to be cleared, Solid Waste will schedule. <u>No Change</u>
