## A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROCLAIMING APRIL 11 THROUGH APRIL 17, 2021, AS NATIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATORS WEEK.

WHEREAS, National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week has been observed in the United States since 1981; and

WHEREAS, this week is designated as a time when citizens can thank public safety men and women who respond to emergency calls and dispatch emergency professionals and equipment during times of crisis. Americans can show gratitude to 9-1-1 call takers, dispatchers, technicians that maintain radio and emergency phone and computer systems, communications staff trainers, communications center personnel, and other public telecommunications staff across the country who work tirelessly, often behind the scenes, to help you during emergencies; and

WHEREAS, emergencies can occur at any time requiring fire, emergency medical services or law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, when an emergency occurs, the prompt response of firefighters, paramedics and law enforcement is critical to the protection of life and preservation of property; and

WHEREAS, Public Safety Emergency Telecommunicators are the first and most critical contact our citizens have with emergency services; and
