**SS210419 - 4:34:54 (Tab C)** Consider a Resolution extending the Local State of Emergency in Nassau County, Florida due to COVID-19 from April 19, 2021 through April 26, 2021.

**Discussion:** Chairman Ford stated that Dr. Eugenia Ngo-Seidel was present via "Zoom". Greg Foster, Director of Emergency Management, came forward stating that he would review various key points on Dr. Siedel's report. The count has gone up since April 16, 2021. He stated that a second case of B117 (UK) variant has been diagnosed in a Nassau County resident. It is important to know that not all positive test are tested for the variant. There have been 32,363 residents vaccinated and 24,336 with vaccination series complete. The Department of Health and Emergency Management continue to ask everyone to comply with the orders given by Center for Disease Control and Florida Department of Health in reference to social distancing, stay away from large crowds, stay home if you are sick, personal hygiene, wash hands, and wear mask if not able to stay the six feet apart. The Department of Health is scheduling vaccinations.
