Dear Mrs. Evans:

A project agreement between the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and Nassau County for construction and construction management of safety improvements on County Road 108 from Middle Road to US Highway 17 began on March 20, 2020 with a completion date of December 31, 2022.

The County solicited for construction bids twice. The first time in Fall of 2020 resulted in only two bidders. When requesting permission from FHWA to move forward with only two bids a few discrepancies were found in the invitation to bid packet and the Board of County Commissioners voted to reject the two bids received and make the corrections. In June of 2021 three bids were received as a result of the second construction solicitation. While three bids were received, due to delays in contract writing and approvals and unprecedented inflation, none of the bidders were able to honor the bids. The bids were rejected by the Board of County Commissioners. A third solicitation is now open for construction bidders.

With the expiration of the grant scheduled for December 31, 2022, Nassau County is respectfully requesting an extension of the agreement for the construction and construction management of the safety improvements on County Road 108 until June 30, 2023, to provide enough time to complete the ITB process and complete the construction work under the LAP agreement.
