FINANCIAL ACTION REQUESTED and Purpose (Attached Documentation if Necessary): According to the latest population estimates from the Bureau of Economic Business and Research (BEBR), Nassau County grew last year (2020-2021) at a rate of 4.21%, which is the 4th fastest growing county in the State of Florida. This rapid growth is commensurate with the 2019-2020 rate increase of 4.92%. Further, for counties with a population of 80,000 or more, Nassau is the 2nd fastest growing county in the State. This growth is not an anomaly. Over the next 15 years, BEBR predicts Nassau will be the 7th fastest growing county with a projected population expansion of 47.5% resulting in over 137,200 people.

Pursuant to Chapter 34, Article II, Section 34-24 (use of monies), of the Comprehensive Impact Fee Ordinance, No. 2020-19, as amended by No. 2021-030, impact fees may be utilized for the construction of new parks and recreation facilities.



In compliance with Ordinance No. 2021-030 and the Nassau County Parks, Recreation, and Open Space Master Plan, the Park Impact Fee and the Recreational Facility Impact Fee (collectively the "Park Impact Fees"), the County's Capital Improvement Plan includes the following projects which require the use of Park Impact Fees from adjacent park and recreation benefit district to provide the approved funding.

- Callahan Ballpark Improvements CIP 000085
- Nassau Crossing Community Park Development CIP 000088
- West Side Regional Park Development CIP 000080-82

To be eligible for the use of adjacent park and recreation benefit district Park Impact Fees collected, it has been determined that (1) the county park system capital improvement will reasonably benefit development in the park and recreation benefit district from which the park and recreational facilities impact fees have been collected; (2) the planned county park system capital improvements are of a nature such that it will add capacity to the county park system beyond the park and recreation benefit district in which it is situated; and (3) the demand for the county park system capital improvement is reasonably attributable to development in the park and recreation benefit district from which the park and recreational facilities impact fees have been collected.

All three capital projects have been included within the Capital Improvement Plan and shall provide additional capacity and facilities to address continuingly growing demands throughout the County.
