A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS EXTENDING THE STATE OF EMERGENCY IN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA DUE TO HURRICANE IAN

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida adopted Resolution No. 2022-188 on September 26, 2022 declaring a state of local emergency in Nassau County, Florida, due to Hurricane Ian; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida adopted Resolution No. 2022-189 on October 10, 2022 extending a state of local emergency in Nassau County, Florida, due to Hurricane Ian; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners exercised its authority under Chapter 252.38(3), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 252.38(3)(5) provides that the duration of the state of emergency declared locally is seven (7) days; and

WHEREAS, the seven (7) day increment may be extended by a majority vote of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, as a result of Hurricane Ian's landfall, the County continues to address damage and recovery efforts within the County, and there exists a need to extend this local State of Emergency to facilitate measures to protect citizens, visitors and property.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, this 10th day of October, 2022 as follows:

The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida does hereby extend the State of Local Emergency for an additional seven-day period through October 17, 2022 due to on-going recovery efforts with Hurricane Ian in areas within the county.
