To the Planning and Zoning Board:

This was also sent via email, but we are sending a hard copy as well, in case the e-version got caught in filters.

We are writing in response to a notice we received about Application No: R22-013, submitted by Patriot Ridge LLP.

Part of the reason we purchased a home in Amelia Walk, and where we did in Amelia Walk, was the established nature of the surroundings in our section of the development.

When we purchased our home, we were told that the pleasant tree line a short distance away and visible from our backyard was a preserve that would never be developed, in part because of the potential for flooding in that area. This would seem to be the very area for which development rezoning has been requested.

While the continued clear-cutting of land in our general area is distressing, and we would prefer that no development happen on the land in question, we realize property owners have rights that need to be respected. That said, with all due respect, we would like to submit the following concerns regarding the developer's request for rezoning:

- Given the flooding concerns cited in the "preserve" narrative many current residents seem to have been provided over the years, how does the developer intend to protect buyers and neighboring homes that may be adversely affected by developing the property?
- What does the developer propose to do about the growing burden of traffic into the area; what access/egress is going to be built into the design of the property, and will the developer assume responsibility for the maintenance of new roads?
- Should this proposed development happen, will any of the tree line be preserved, in order to delineate the new development from neighboring properties and preserve the local aesthetic?

Those of us in Conserve Nassau are concerned about the rezoning and development of the parcels identified in R22-013 for the following reasons. Please view the attached slides for clarification of our points.

We have seen dramatic loss of tree canopy in this part of the county (see slide 3) and are concerned that we:

- will not have sufficient canopy to process stormwater

- create flooding since so much of this area is potential wetland (see slide 4)
- create great warming in this part of the county (heat island effect) with so much impervious surface

We are also concerned that, because of the extent of development in this part of the county (see slide 5), there are few areas left where wildlife can survive, particularly if their habitat requires space for hunting or foraging.

As a result, we highly recommend that Mr. Matovina conserve this land through sale to the CLAM program or development of a conservation easement on this property through the CLAM program.

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I, along with several neighbors, have been going door to door to make everyone aware of the proposed zoning change. So many people didn't know! We've been collecting signatures along the way as a show of opposition to the zoning change. We didn't make it to every house, but I've attached the signatures of the people that we were able to speak with. Most signers are from Nassauville, but we also have the support of others in the area. Over and over, I hear that folks are here because it is a rural community.

This morning, a Monday morning, from 815am until 915am, I sat at the intersection of Richard Drive and Hendricks Road. The intersection of Greenberry Road and Hendricks Road was right behind me. In that hour, two cars passed through the Greenberry intersection. Eight cars passed through the Richard Drive intersection (includes the two that turned onto Greenberry). This area will be bombarded with over 2000 cars a day if the zoning is changed to RS-2. This will change our neighborhoods immensely! There are few sidewalks, few streetlights, and few dividing lines on the road. This kind of traffic will end our ability to ride bikes, horses or take a simple walk around our own neighborhood.

I was surprised to learn that a traffic study isn't required until a site engineering plan review. If 267 houses are approved now, but then we discover, later, that the roads can't handle the traffic, are we stuck with this mistake? Or maybe, for only five years, until a new road is built? This is unacceptable. From a quality-of-life standpoint, it will be too late, as most of us live here for the lack of traffic. A specific plan needs to be agreed upon before deciding something as life-altering as this zoning change. This change will affect hundreds of existing area households and lives.

I've measured the widths of some of our backroads. I'm finding an average of 20 feet with a mere 18 feet on Karen Walk near Dwight Drive. I've also measured the widths of fire trucks, ambulances, and construction trucks. I imagine school buses are the same. They average 8 feet with mirrors extending another foot on each side, for a total of 10 feet. We know from watching other developments, there will be a constant stream of trucks going in and out. On our small roads, will they drive in the drainage ditches to pass each other? Will they knock down our mailboxes? There's *literally* no room on these backroads for any construction traffic.

If we follow the flow of traffic with the proposed plan, we end up at the intersection of Hendricks Road and Old Nassauville Road. How long will it take to make a left-hand turn, as most cars do? Back-ups are guaranteed. There will be even more traffic on Old Nassauville Rd. travelling past Hendricks Rd. from the new development on Tyson Rd. and other projects that are still in the planning stages. The potential for serious accidents at this intersection is great, especially at night on our dark roads.

I believe the best option is to keep this property zoned as open rural, as it was purchased, with access directly to Amelia Concourse. I've heard Old Nassauville Rd. described as Nassau County's problem child. You, as our Commissioners, have the power to stop this problem from escalating! Less homes equals less traffic. Open rural zoning equals less homes. Keep this traffic off our rural roads. Keep Nassauville rural!
