Dear Mr. Huppman,

We are reaching out ahead of the 28th annual Amelia Island Concours d'Elegance which is scheduled to take place Thursday, February 29th, through Sunday, March 3rd, 2024, at The Ritz-Carlton and Golf Club of Amelia Island. As in past years, we sincerely appreciated the cooperation of Nassau County and its residents.

We would like to request access to Peter's Point beginning Monday, February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024, as we start the build out on the Golf Club of Amelia Island. Our request includes:

- 1. The use of one half of Peter's Point from 6:00 a.m., Monday, February 19th through Wednesday, February 28th at 11:59 a.m.
- 2. The use of all of Peter's Point (with exception of the handicapped spots) from 12:01 p.m., Wednesday, February 28th, through Monday, March 4th, 2024, at 11:59 a.m. This will provide parking for show car transport vehicles and create access to the show field for show cars that are not street legal. Additionally, the access road to the beach would remain open to the public and handicapped spaces would still be available to the public. The Concours would provide the necessary temporary barriers to ensure that traffic flows smoothly onto the beach.
- 3. The use of Scott Road Beach Access parking area from 8 a.m., Thursday, February 28th, 2024, through Sunday, March 3rd, 2024, at 8 p.m. This would be used by Media and Vendors. Hagerty will provide on-site security during these hours. We will keep 15 spaces open and available for public use as well as the access road to the beach.
- 4. The approval for the Amelia Island Concours to install, on County property, a temporary six-foot, chain-link fence. This will extend from the drive entering The Ritz-Carlton, east of the sidewalk on A 1A around to the Summer Beach pool and on to the Carlton Dunes wall in Peter's Point. This will prevent unauthorized access to the show field.

Hagerty agrees to supply Nassau County with a Hold Harmless Agreement. Please let me know if there is anything else you need to facilitate the process of obtaining approval from the County.
