## EVALUATION COMMITTEE MEETING TO EVALUATE PROPOSALS RECEIVED FOR

## DESIGN CRITERIA PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR THE NASSAU COUNTY SHERIFF'S VEHICLE STORAGE GARAGE - BID NO. NC17-007 CONTRACT MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE ROOM THURSDAY, APRIL 13, 2017 – 9:30 A.M.

A meeting of the Evaluation Committee was held this 13th of April 2017 at 9:30 a.m. in the Contract Management Conference Room at the James S. Page Governmental Complex, Yulee, Florida, to conduct an evaluation of the proposals received for the Design Criteria Professional Services for the Sheriff's Garage, Bid No, NC17-007 in order to formulate a recommendation to be presented to the Board of County Commissioners. Voting members present were Frank Mashuda, Facilities Maintenance Director; Bill Howard, Building Supervisor, and Mike Edwards representing the Sheriff's Office. Also present was Justin Stankiewicz, Office of Management and Budget and Assistant County Manager (non-voting), as facilitator; and Connie Arthur, recording secretary.

Mr. Stankiewicz called the meeting to order at 9:37 a.m. He explained that the purpose of the meeting was to review submittals for the Design Criteria Professional Services the Sheriff's Garage, Bid No. NC17-007. He explained that there were two submittals received from Skanska USA Building, Inc. and CRA Architects for Bid No. NC17-007. All committee members indicated that they did not have any conflicts of interest that may preclude them from participating in this committee nor any contact with the bidders.

Mr. Stankiewicz explained that the committee members had been provided criteria sheets to evaluate each firm that submitted a proposal. He explained that each committee member has the ranking criteria that were provided in the Request for Qualifications (RFQ). If there are significant variances in scores, discussion will take place to determine the variance if scores were outside the maximum point range. Mr. Stankiewicz explained that he will record the scores for the firm and calculate the final score.

The committee members read aloud their scores for CRA Architects as follows:

Each evaluation committee member provided explanations for their scoring as reported on their ranking sheets. Mr. Stankiewicz explained that the goal of this committee was to shortlist the top three firms; however, only two proposals were received. He explained that the committee will evaluate these two firms in order to form a recommendation to the Board.

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Mr. Stankiewicz tallied the scoring and provided the total and average composite score for the firms according to the qualifications and work plan as follows:

Based upon the average composite score, it would provide for a recommendation from the Evaluation Committee to the Board of County Commissioners to enter into contract negotiations with CRA Architects.

It was moved by Mr. Masuda, seconded by Mr. Howard and unanimously carried to recommend to the Board of County Commissioners to enter into contract negotiations with CRA Architects for the Design Criteria for the Sheriff's Garage Project, Bid No. NC17-007.


