AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, RESCINDING ORDINANCE 2011-14 WHICH CREATED CERTAIN EXEMPTIONS TO OWNERS OF SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENCES, INCLUDING MANUFACTURED RESIDENTIAL HOMES, FROM PERMITTING AND CODE REQUIREMENTS OF THE FLORIDA BUILDING CODE, SECTION 102.2.5, AS AMENDED, AND FLORIDA STATUTES SECTION 553.80(3), WHO PERFORM THEIR OWN CONSTRUCTION OF PORCHES, DECKS, PATIOS AND STORAGE SHEDS ON THEIR PROPERTY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

That Ordinance No. 2011-14 is hereby rescinded in its entirety, as set forth in Section 7-7 of the Code of Laws and Ordinances of Nassau County, Florida. 2.
