Monthly Activity Report June, 2017

The Building Department issued 916 permits in June, 50 more than issued in May. Permit revenues received for June were \$238,217 or 32% higher than May permit revenues of \$179,681. For comparison, there were 913 permits issued in June, 2016.

The Building Department continued to scan documents for digital archival of records during June. Scanning of current permits is now being completed upon issuance, therefore eliminating the need to keep any additional paper copies. Digital archived records ensure that public records are created, maintained and disposed of in accordance with Florida Statutes. The digital archival of records also enables public records requests for permit and plans information to be completed in a more timely and efficient manner. Records Management began working on updating the scanning software to DocStar which will replace the current Doculex software.

The Building Department began using the new Tyler Technologies Munis Permitting and Inspection system January, 9, 2017. More contractors are using the on-line feature to schedule inspections, view inspection results and enter trade permits as well. Inspectors are being trained to record inspection results in the field and contractors will eventually be able to review these as soon as they are entered. We are diligently working to have these features available by the end of this fiscal year.

Redrafted unsafe building abatement code for review by the County Attorney. The unsafe Building abatement code draft will be presented to the Board of County Commissioners as soon as reviewed and approved by County Attorney's office.

Building Official attended BOAF First Coast Chapter meeting in June. Presentation was by Simpson Strong-Tie on Continuous Load Paths.

Building Official and the Sr. Plans Examiner attended the Building Official Association's 2017 annual conference and expo in June. Continuing education credits for licensing are earned for completion of training classes at the conference.

Permitting Department:

The Permitting Department processed and issued the following permits for the month of June, 2017.

103 New Single-family residence permits

- a. 13 at less than \$200,000 valuation
- b. 25 at \$200,000 to \$250,000 valuation
- c. 59 above \$250,000 valuation
- d. 1 Multi Family 6 units
- 1 New Mobile/Modular home permit
- 11 Replacement Mobile home permits
- 801 Accessory permits (Mechanical, Plumbing, additions, repairs, commercial Build-outs, etc)

The department average plan review for the issuance of new single-family residence and mobile home permits has increased to four to five weeks due to the recent surge in activity and staff working on the computer software conversion project. Some repair/remodel and addition permits being issued in less than two weeks and three weeks on commercial projects provided there are no unforeseen problems with the application.

<u>Inspections Department:</u>

Building Inspectors completed 3265 inspections in June, 2017.

A Building Inspector I successfully passed training and examination for licensing as Residential Mechanical Inspector.

Building Inspector II successfully completed training on Changes to the Florida Residential Energy Conservation Code given by Florida Solar Energy Center. Completion entitles additional education credits for Inspector Licensing
