1. Approve Tabs A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, N, and O.
2. Tab I - Continue to August 28, 2017 at 6:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, consideration of an Ordinance of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, establishing an Art in Public Places Program, providing for purpose; providing for definitions; providing for establishing committee roles and responsibilities; providing for ownership and maintenance; providing for severability; and providing for an effective date.
3. Approved to combine the following Ordinance into one Ordinance: **(Tab J)** Consideration of an Ordinance of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, adopting the 5th Edition (2014) Florida Building Code; and providing an effective date. **(Tab K)** Consideration of an Ordinance Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, rescinding Ordinance No. 2012-07, which adopted the 2010 Florida Building Code with Amendments; providing an effective date. **(Tab L)** Consideration of an Ordinance of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, rescinding Ordinance No. 2011-14 which created certain exemptions to owners of single-family residences including manufactured residential homes, from permitting and code requirements of the Florida Building Code, Section 102.2.5, as amended, and Florida Statutes, Section 553.80(3), who perform their own construction of porches, decks, patios and storage sheds on their property; and providing an effective date.

Tab M - Continue to September 25, 2017 at 6:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, consideration of an Ordinance of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, amending Ordinance No. 97-19, as amended, known as the Nassau County Land Development Code, specifically amending Article 33, Distance Restrictions for Certain Land Uses; Section 33.01, Vendors of Alcoholic/Intoxicating Beverages and Bottle Clubs, specifically Section 33.01(A), Section 33.01 (D), Section 33.01(E) and Section 33.01(F); providing for findings; providing

for severability; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.
