Dear Ms. Hiers-Bray:

Due to extraordinary and unexpected increase in the level of service and equipment repair and replacement that has occurred for "Non-Routine" repair events at the West Nassau Landfill Gas Collection and Control System (flare station and wellfield), it appears that S2L, Incorporated (S2Li) does not have sufficient funds remaining within our present Work Authorization to complete the needed operations and maintenance for the last quarter of this fiscal year. Over the last four fiscal years, S2Li has completed these services under the firm's estimated budget. However, this current fiscal year has been unusually challenging. Since the beginning of this fiscal year, S2Li has been faced with a number of emergency events, including repair of the damage to the flare station caused by Hurricane Irma, and the failure of equipment, which collectively resulted in the expenditure of contingency funding well in excess of that anticipated. A summary of major "Non-Routine" events that required additional cost for labor, parts, materials, and equipment rentals are as follows:

- Purchase and repair to electronic and control parts due to damage caused by Hurricane Irma.
- Manual (in lieu of automated) operations of the Flare Station due to damage caused by Hurricane Irma.
- Purchase and installation of a new control valve actuator.
- Purchase of parts, equipment rental, and labor associated with the re-sloping of lateral pipe at gas wells GW-6 and GW-17.
- Purchase and installation for new gas cylinder rack, gas regulator, and hose connections.
- Purchase of parts, materials, and labor associated with installing air regulators and ball valves at two air compressors.
- Purchase of parts, materials, and labor associated with installing new flare arrestor seals.
- Purchase of parts, materials, and labor associated with replacing failed control valve, connection module, and backup actuator.
- Manual (in lieu of automated) operations of the Flare Station due to automatic control valve failure.
- Equipment rental and labor associated with the assessment of landfill gas well failures.
- Preparation and submittal of several reports to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) (both the Northeast District and the Department of Air Resources in Tallahassee) requesting time extensions, requests for Alternate Operating Procedures, and the notice of failing wells.

The anticipated scheduled and routine work that remains to be completed by September 30, 2018 include the following:

- Monthly New Source Performance Standard (NSPS) Well Measurements and Reporting.
- Follow-up wellfields adjustments and field maintenance associated with out of compliance wells.
- · Quarterly blower grease replacement.
- NSPS Semi-Annual Report to FDEP for the period of January through June 2018.
- Method 22 testing at the flare.

To provide the remaining routine services and funding for limited contingencies for non-routine emergencies events, S2Li is requesting a change order for increased funds under its Work Authorization No. CM2096-WA22 in the amount of \$60,000. An estimate that details anticipated expenditures associated with this request is attached. Any expenditure of these additional funds will be in accordance with the firm's Agreement on a time and materials basis, with no markup of purchased parts.
